The concert lost a total of £1352.

Ticket sales at the box office were 310 and the Choir sold a further 16 seats from our allocation of tickets.

In essence, we were about 50 seats short of our break even point.

Despite the disappointing financial outcome, we had a fantastic evening.

We are not alone in finding it difficult to sell concert tickets in the current climate. Huddersfield Choral are giving tickets away – when did that last happen!

The Town Hall is booked for next year and we recognise the importance of a Town Hall concert to the local profile of the Choir.
